This is a new show hall for us this year! Located just a few miles southwest of Cedar Rapids on Hwy 151. Everything in on one level, only one step to get into the building! Plenty of free parking.

Show Motel: Best Western Coopers Mill, 100 F Avenue NW, Cedar Rapids. 800-528-1234 or 319 366-5323. Restaurant, cocktail lounge & indoor pool are some of the features of the motel. Please mention the cat show when making your reservation. Most chain motels are also in the area, e-mail the entry clerk for an additional list.

Check-in will be 7:00am – 8:00am Saturday with judging beginning at 8:30. Sunday check-in will also begin at 7:00am with judging beginning at 8am. Exhibitors will be marked absent if not checked in 15 minutes prior to the start of judging. Exhibitors must be present to claim all final awards unless prior permission has been received from the show manager. Published show hours are until 4:00pm.

This show will be run strictly according to the show rules of the American Cat Fanciers Association, Inc. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to know the show rules. A copy of the show rules is available from ACFA Central Office, PO Box 1949, Nixa MO 65174-1949; 417-725-1530 or ACFA@sol.com. This show will be scored for ACFA Inter-American and Regional Awards. Ribbons & Rosettes will be awarded in all rings.

**** All cats in the show hall must be free of fleas, ear mites, fungus and show no signs of contagious disease, illness or neglect. Kittens must be able to show proof of age.**

Important: It is recommended that all entries be fully immunized against feline enteritis, rhinotracheitis, calici viruses and rabies. Any entry from a household where there has been a contagious illness within 21 days prior to the opening day of the show will be prohibited from entering the show hall. A veterinarian will be on call 24 hours. If the show committee deems it necessary to call a Veterinarian, the exhibitor will be responsible for all charges. All entries must have their claws trimmed prior to judging.

Sales Cages are available for exhibitors only. Kittens for exhibition or sale must be 4 months old to be in the show hall and be owned by the exhibitor. FKFI, Inc. supports serious reputable breeders! No cats or kittens may be benched or sold from carriers under the benching area or from the parking areas. No non-pedigree cat or kitten may be sold or given away at the show.

Litter will be provided. Please bring your own litter pans, food & water dishes, and coverings for the top, bottom, back and sides of your benching cage. A single cage is 22"x22"x45". If you own your own benching cage you must request enough cage space so you will have enough room.

This show is for the display and competition of cats. With respect to the enjoyment of our exhibitors, judges, vendors and spectators, and to the health & welfare of our entries; we retain the right to refuse any entry. Well behaved children are welcome.

Vendors: Booth space is \$55 for a 8' x 10' space which includes one 8' table. Additional tables and space is available. Please contact Marlys Bartling for vendor information 319-351-6044.
