Show Rules: This show will be run strictly according to the rules of the American Cat Fanciers Association (ACFA). It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to know the show rules. A copy of the show rules is available for \$7.00 from ACFA, P.O. Box 1949, Nixa, MO 65714-1949 or <http://www.acfacat.com/>.

Overpayments: All overpayments will be accepted as donations.

Check-In: 7:00 to 8:00 A.M. on Saturday with judging starting at 8:30 A.M. Sunday check-in will be 7:00 to 7:30 A.M. with judging starting at 8:00 A.M. Anyone not checked in by end of check-in will be marked absent. You must be present to claim all final awards unless PRIOR PERMISSION IS RECEIVED FROM THE SHOW MANAGER. Advertised show hours will be from 9 AM - 4 PM.

Clerks: Clerks will be paid the equivalent of one entry fee for clerking both days. Lunch will be provided. If interested, please indicate on your entry form. Clerks will be assigned according to experience and will be paid at the end of the show. Please do not deduct from your fees.

Supplies: Bring your own supplies, such as food, water, litter box and bed, just to be sure you have what you need. Litter will be provided.

Cages: Remember GSCC cages are larger than at most shows. Cage size will be **22"x22"x25"** for a single and **22"x22"x54"** for a double. Exhibitors need to bring coverings for the top, sides and bottom of the cage.

Health: All cats/kittens must have their front and back claws trimmed or it will be done by a club member at a charge of \$5.00. All entries must be inoculated against Feline Enteritis, Rhinotracheitis and Calici Virus. Entries must be free of fleas, ear mites and fungus. Any entry(s) from a household where there has been a feline infectious illness within 21 days prior to the show will not be allowed in the show hall.

Kittens: No kitten under the age of 4 months will be allowed in the show hall. No cats or kittens will be allowed to be kept under the show bench or under grooming tables. Kittens in the show hall must have been born on or before December 23, 2004.

Entries: There will be no refunds after the closing date, April 12, 2005. No entries will be confirmed or entered in the catalog without payment. Entries will be taken and confirmed on a first come basis.

Liability: There will be no watchman on duty overnight in the show hall. Neither GSCC nor the Farmington Ice Arena will not be responsible for any loss, damage or accidents to cats or property or assume liability whatsoever for injury, loss or damage to any person or property.

Transfers: **Transfers for Sunday must be made with the Master Clerk during the show on Saturday.** No transfers will be accepted Sunday unless entered for Sunday only. All championship entries should be registered before the show.

Amenities: There will be people food available. THIS IS A NONSMOKING SHOW HALL.

Ribbons/Rosettes: Rosettes will be awarded in all 10 rings. Breed ribbons or cards will be awarded where available. **Donations to the ribbon fund will be greatly appreciated and acknowledged in the catalog.**

Sales Cages: Sales cages will be available to EXHIBITORS ONLY! Minimum price for a cat or kitten is \$125.00.

Note: This show is for the display and competition of cats. Well behaved children are welcome.

If you have not received your confirmation by April 15, 2005, call the Entry Clerk between 8 - 10 P.M. only for confirmation that your entry was received. Gopher State Cat Club WILL NOT be responsible for entries lost or delayed in the mail (this includes e-mail).
